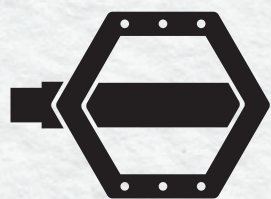

GENERAL INFORMATION



The UCI Gran Fondo Greece Loutraki 2025 cycling event is a «**Cycling for All**» race with the participation of Elite, U23, Juniors, Masters and Sportive athletes (with or without a racing card).

The event is organized by **Kyvernitis Travel Group, Sports & Events Division**, together with the **Municipality of Loutraki-Perachora-Agioi Theodoroi** and the **Municipality of Megara**.

The UCI Gran Fondo Greece Loutraki race is taking place on **Sunday, 2 November 2025** along routes in the regions of Peloponnese and West Attica. It is held under the auspices of the Hellenic Cycling Federation (EOP), the Region of Attica, the Region of Peloponnese, and SETE, and is conducted in accordance with the regulations of the Hellenic Cycling Federation (EOP) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

The race is **included in the official UCI racing schedule** and **qualifies for the finals of the UCI Gran Fondo World Series** taking place in Niseko, Hokkaido, Japan on 26-30 August 2026.

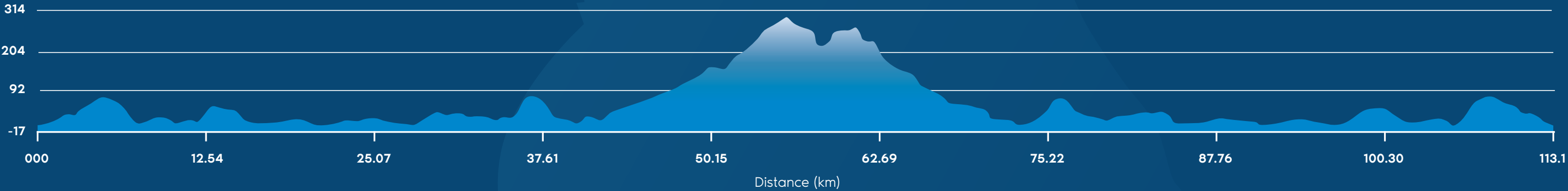

GENERAL REGULATIONS

PARTICIPATION IN RACES (INDIVIDUAL, TEAM) – CATEGORIES

- Participation is allowed for the following categories of athletes:
By participating in the UCI Gran Fondo, you participate in one of the sporting events organized or approved by sports federations. **Therefore, to participate, you must provide one of the following:**
- **Valid HCF (Hellenic Cycling Federation) license for 2025.**
 - **Valid National Federation license (from any UCI-affiliated Cycling Federation) for 2025.**
 - **or, for those who do not hold such a license and are eligible to participate in these races, presentation of a medical certificate only or a copy thereof, which must be dated within one year from the date of the race.**

On-site checks on the authenticity of medical certificates and licences will be carried out. Participants must be able to provide these items when they receive their match numbers or during the event.

The ages of the athletes are calculated based on the year of birth (not the date of birth).



SAFETY & RESPONSIBILITY

- Cycling in general and competitive cycling in particular is a physical activity with risks.** Each participant in the event must take part in the knowledge that he or she will be cycling on mountainous terrain with intense climbs and rapid descents. The Organizer will put in place several measures to ensure the safety of the route: signposting, motorbikes, and signs indicating passages requiring particular attention. Throughout the course, **participants must comply with the safety instructions and instructions of the Commissaires, race personnel (Police, civil protection, safety Motorbike Marshals, volunteers, etc.).** The safety arrangements for the race end when the finish line is crossed. Participants must respect the applicable highway code in all circumstances. However, a safety concept with an information car, safety motorbikes and a broom wagon, as well as marshals at junctions, will ensure that the race is supervised.
- At level crossings, participants must stop when a train passes.
 - Roundabouts only passed on the right.
 - Participants must ride on the right-hand side of the road.

Any participant who has had or witnessed an accident, or who needs medical assistance, is obliged to help others and to call the emergency number shown on his/her race number. The participant remains solely responsible for any incident, accident, or breach of the event regulations. Any costs arising from medical attention (ambulance, doctor, hospitalization, etc.) are the responsibility of the participant concerned. The liability of the Organizer, its employees, and other auxiliaries for direct or indirect damage suffered by a participant as part of or in connection with his or her participation in the event is expressly excluded, whether in the event of accident, theft or damage of any kind. By registering, you confirm that you are covered by this insurance and waive any legal action against the Organiser. Motorised assistance or private following vehicles on the course are strictly forbidden. Offenders will be reported to the police. By registering, each participant confirms that he/she has read all the information, particularly that relating to safety, and undertakes to comply with it.

EQUIPMENT

- All participants must carry with them throughout the course and for the duration of the event:
- A rigid helmet, with a chinstrap fastened,
 - A mobile phone with a charged battery, to be used only in urgent situations
 - A bib number, - A framed plate with the emergency number,
 - A hydration system (water bottle or hydration bag).

In the event of adverse weather forecasts (heavy rain and cool temperatures), the organisers reserve the right to require participants to carry a survival jacket and blanket. Each participant is responsible for carrying equipment suited to the conditions on the day of the event. It is forbidden to change bikes during the race. Riders may use only road bikes approved by UCI. In road races, time trial bikes are prohibited. During the qualifying events for the UCI Gran Fondo World Championships, all bikes may be inspected to check that they comply with UCI regulations. Participants are free to wear the jersey of their choice in the qualifying rounds.

QUALIFICATION THROUGH THE UCI GRAN FONDO WORLD SERIES

Each UCI Gran Fondo World Series event confers qualification rights for the UCI Gran Fondo World Championships. The top 25% of athletes in their age group qualify for the UCI Gran Fondo World Championships. This 25% is calculated based on the number of starts in each age group, not the number of riders crossing the finish line. In addition, the top three riders in each official age group qualify automatically for the World Championships, regardless of the number of starts in that age group. Riders must finish the race to qualify. A rider's age group is calculated based on his age on 31 December of the year of the 2024 UCI Gran Fondo World Championships.

The main award in the UCI Gran Fondo series is the right to compete in the UCI Gran Fondo World Championships, where top age-group finishers win the UCI rainbow jersey. Qualification is granted to the top 25% of riders in each age category at the various UCI Gran Fondo World Series events, with automatic qualification for the top three in each age group. The Rainbow Jersey and World Championship UCI Gran Fondo World Championships: This is the ultimate goal of the series, serving as the World Championship for amateur and master cyclists. Rainbow Jersey: The winners in each age category at the World Championships are awarded the coveted rainbow jersey, a symbol of being the world champion in their category. Qualification for the World Championships top 25%: At each qualifying event in the UCI Gran Fondo World Series, the top 25% of riders in each age group earn a spot in the World Championships. Automatic Qualification: The top three riders in any age group qualify automatically, regardless of how many riders are in that specific group.

Age Groupings:

A rider's age group is determined by their age on December 31st of the year of the World Championships.

How to Qualify:

■ Participate in a UCI Gran Fondo World Series Event: Find a local Gran Fondo event that is part of the UCI Gran Fondo World Series.

■ Achieve a Top Ranking: Aim to finish in the top 25% of your age category or among the top three for automatic qualification.

■ Race at the World Championships: If you qualify, you will get to compete against the best amateur and master cyclists from around the world for the prestigious rainbow jersey.

Both Race numbers and Timing chips can be collected upon presentation of the following:

- Your license or medical certificate that meets the above conditions.
- The notification letter sent via email before the event.
- Your proof of identity.

Saturday, 1 November 2025, from 10:00 to 20:00 at the Club Hotel Casino Loutraki. The distribution of bib numbers is fixed and definitive. Bib numbers cannot be sent by post or given on the day of the event. The Bib Number must be placed on your back and will be mandatory to access the starting area and must remain fully visible throughout the race, including in case of bad weather.

REGISTRATION – PARTICIPATION FEE

The registration cannot be transferred to another person. I confirm that all information I have provided here is true and I know and am fully responsible that in case of providing false information, I am liable to the Organizer for any damage that may arise. Each participant receives an attractive package for the cost of participation:

- Marked track and closed route
- Professional timing
- Feed station on the route
- Technical service on the route
- Medical service en route
- Medal for each finisher.
- UCI medal for the top 25% of each age category
- UCI Gran Fondo World Series jersey for each winner in their age category
- Guarded bicycle parking

Payments to the Secretariat of the race will be accepted, only with prior notification by the participant to the event, and an additional charge of 15€ and only by Credit Cards, no cash allowed to the race.

RACE DETAILS – SPECIAL REGULATIONS

In general, the regulations of the HCF (Hellenic Cycling Federation) and UCI apply, and in particular for road cycling races. A start will be given for all categories of cyclists at once. The use of a road bike is mandatory.



TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

There will be technical service vehicles, with a mechanic and equipped with various wheels as well as water and fruit. The neutral service vehicles will move as below and always according to the instructions of the Commissaires.

- One (1) vehicle at the front of the race.
- One (1) vehicle will be at the end of the race (broom vehicle) supported by Top Cycles
- One (1) more vehicle behind the President's of the Commissaires car

All vehicles will have a special marking, and indication «NEUTRAL RACE SUPPORT». Under no circumstances are they allowed to overtake the Commissaires vehicles, and they are not allowed to give instructions to cyclists.

FEED ZONES

Along the way, there will be two (2) feed zones. In any case, there will be signage for each supply zone, as well as warning signs 5km and 1km before the supply zone. In each supply zone, there will be water, isotonic drinks fruits and/or other foods such as energy bars, etc.

TIME LIMITS

For safety reasons, riders must comply with the timing limits set, in the intermediate check points. There are 2 intermediate check points as follows:

- At the end of Kineta village (km 30 of the race), where the time limit is 30 minutes behind the head of the race.
- In Kato Pefkaneas, Top of the Megara Hill climb (km 55 of the race) where the time limit is 1 hour 15 minutes behind the head of the race.

Failing to pass through the above-mentioned checkpoints before the above times limits, the participant can still continue the race, if he/she wishes to do so, BUT UNDER HIS/HER RESPONSIBILITY, RESPECTING THE TRAFFIC RULES OF THE COUNTRY (semaphores, STOP signs etc),

Time Limit at the finish line: 5 hours and 30 Minutes from the start to the race.

If a participant wishes to retire, he / she must report to one of the checkpoints set up by the Organizers or to the Commissaires Panel or to the safety Motorbike Marshals who will take away their number and instruct them how to get back to the race headquarters. Anyone abandoning the race outside the checkpoints must immediately report this to the **race management (Race Director, Commissaires, safety Motorbike Marshals, etc)**. Failure to do so may result in costs being incurred by the competitor. Any participant who suffers a fall, mechanical breakdown, or physical problems and who is unable to continue the race by his means **must immediately notify the race management (as above) announcing** his withdrawal and his race number. Any participant who is reported for using his/her mobile phone, during the race, will be **IMMEDIATELY disqualified from the race**. The medical service, made up of doctors, first-aiders, and ambulances, may decide to withdraw a participant from the race for medical reasons. Each cyclist, in order to be considered as having completed the UCI Gran-Fondo and to get a ranking, must have completed the race in **5 Hours and 30 minutes (time limit)**. The Commissaires Panel will periodically check the status of the race (in relation to the time limit). One (1) vehicle will be in the queue of the race convoy (sweep vehicle), behind the last participant, with the indication «BROOM WAGON». Cyclists gradually dropped behind, can continue on the route within the "Race Bubble", **EXCEPT IF REPORTED OUT OF THE TIME LIMITS**, where they can continue, but respecting the traffic rules of the country, with their responsibility for their personal safety, and will pay special attention to points required (traffic

lights, descents, intersections, level crossings, etc.). The UCI Gran-Fondo is a racing event, which takes place on a public road (facilitating the movement of cyclists regarding the racing part), and all participants must respect the traffic regulations whether they are moving on the Gran-Fondo or non-racing track. The race marking will remain on the course throughout the race day. The arrows indicate the direction of the race, while there will be signs for the first **30km** as well as the last **25, 20, 10, 5, 3, 1km, 500m, 300, 200m, 150m, 100m and 50m**. Indicative signs. In order to be easily distinguishable from the participants and the staff of the race, there will be special markings on the vehicles (windshields) involved in the race. A cyclist who receives assistance from an unauthorized vehicle will be penalized, in accordance with the Regulations and following a decision of the by the Commissaires Panel.

RANKINGS – AWARDS – PRIZES

General Individual Classification, Classification by age category, as mentioned above and formed at the end of the participation forms. The top three winners in each age group will take to the podium for the prize. Each cyclist who finishes within the time limit of 5 hours, will receive a commemorative participation medal.

AWARDS

The awards ceremony will take place at the venue at the **Finish Area at 14:00**. For age groups, where the podium has not been completed, the award ceremony will take place immediately after the end of the first three of the age group. The winners will arrive in their racing attire and without bicycles. The first three in each age category are for women and men and the first 25% in each category will be called at the ceremony. The Organiser reserves the right to establish the prize board. **The first three finishers in each category must present their race number and proof of identity to receive their prize.** The prize must be collected on-site on the day of the race.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL – ETHICS

In case the National Anti-Doping Agency decides on controls, there will be information for those involved, in accordance with the regulations of the HCF and the UCI. The Organizer places great emphasis on the Olympic values of **excellence, friendship, and respect**, which are the cornerstone of fair and sustainable sports. Participants must treat other competitors, organizers, volunteers, and spectators with respect. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify participants who behave violently or discriminate verbally against anyone.

PENALTIES

The race will be subject to the penalties referred to in the regulations of the HCF and, where not foreseen, the UCI. The President of the Commissaires is announced by the HCF.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

To respect the environment and the natural areas crossed, it is strictly forbidden to leave rubbish (paper, plastic packaging, tubes containing energy gels, etc.) on the course. Refuse bins and «**collection zones**» will be set up and signposted at each refreshment post along the route. Participants must use them. Participants must keep their rubbish and packaging until the Organizer has indicated a place to dispose of it. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify participants who deliberately dispose of their rubbish outside the designated areas.

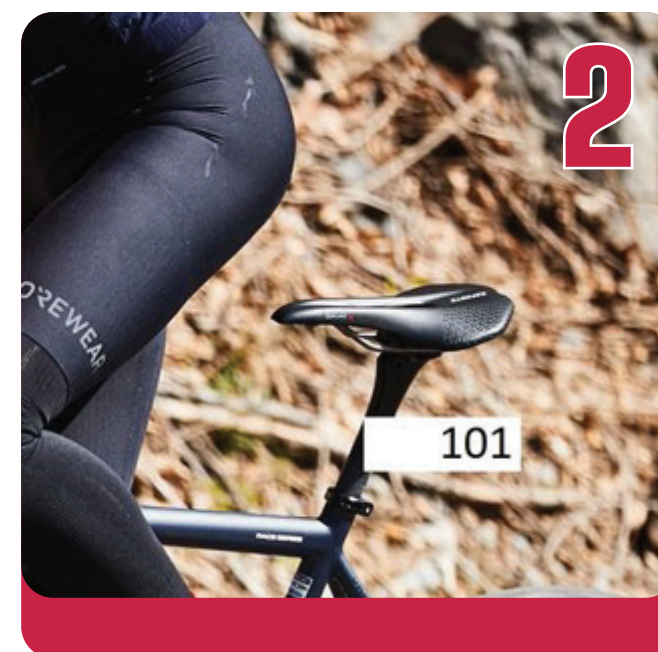

TIMING



Before the race, all athletes must **mount the active timing chip on the front fork** of the bike using the provided cable strap (Photo 1). **The return of the active chip is mandatory. A penalty of 100€ will apply if you do not return the active chip.**



The **seatpost sticker** with the backup passive chip should also **be attached** as shown in Photo 2.



Additionally, please **wear your race numbers on the lower back of your jersey**, one on the left and one on the right, using safety pins (Photo 3).
